DO

Do put the following in the FFL bags

Any marine litter found at sea which could be:




- ✓ Ghost gear
- ✓ Beverage Containers
- ✓ Any or types of plastics
- ✓ Rubber
- ✓ Textiles
- ✓ Metal



DON'T

Don't put the following in the FFL bags:

- ✗ Your galley waste
 - ✗ Your clean net cut offs
 - ✗ Your retired gear
- Don't put **Special Waste** categories in that need to be handled carefully such as:
- ✗ Oily drums
 - ✗ Oily rags
 - ✗ Air/water filters
 - ✗ Batteries



Ask you harbour master about any of the above items for safe disposal.
